

Dale E. Till, age 79, passed away on January 3, 2017 in Port Charlotte, Florida after battling cancer for 45 years.

He was born in Dunkirk, NY on March 13, 1937 to Edward W. Till and Mary Gibbons. Since 2000 he had wintered in Punta Gorda, Florida and summered in Fredonia, NY.

He is survived by his wife of 51 years, Ann; a daughter, Michelle (Nick) Pasyanos of Amawalk, NY; and sons, Edward (Tamyra) Till of Castile, NY and Jay Till of Warsaw, NY. He was a collector of sports memorabilia, breweriana and loved to travel. Dale donated his body to a medical research facility.
