A graduate of Panama Central School, Jolene starred at Edinboro University. She was inducted into their Hall of Fame in 1994

After serving as an assistant at the University of North Carolina, she became the head coach at

Cornell and later Georgetown before taking over at Duke ten years ago. She led the Blue Devils to a 27-6 record in 2009 and is approaching 400 career NCAA wins.
